AN ACT to amend the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.

A.D. 2016 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:-

Short title. Cap. 51:02

1. This Act, which amends the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act, may be cited as the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Amendment) Act 2016.

Amendment of section 28of the Principal Act. 2. Section 28(1) of the Principal Act is amended by inserting in the proviso immediately after the word "State" the words "or any other person who is sixty-five years old and over".

Amendment of the First Schedule to the Principal Act. The First Schedule to the Principal Act is amended by the substitution for it of the following Schedule -

- (a) no licence fee shall be payable in respect of any invalid carriage;
- (b) nolicence shall be required for any motor vehicle ortrailer if used only within the bounds of any sugarcane plantation, wood cutting grant, cattle farm, lot or farm under cultivation, cocoa estate, rubber estate, private grant, mining or placer claim;
- (c) initem 4, "passengers", include the driver;
- (d)the Minister may, by order, define districts in which the fee for anytrailer used in connection with amotor car shall beone half of theappropriate amount set out in item 10

Where there has been payment for vehicle or trailer of a licence fee from which the motor vehicle or trailer is, upon the application of the licence holder shown to the satisfaction of the licensing officer to have, by virtue of any such order published in the Gazette after the payment in question, been exempted to the extent of any amount so paid in respect of any periodcommencing on or after the coming into operation of the order, such amount shall pursuant to the said application, and uponsurrender of the licence if such period is unexpired, be refunded byor on the authority of the Licensing Authority; and any decision of the licensingofficer with which theapplicant is dissatisfied shall besubject to appeal, which shall lie in the like manner as anappeal under the proviso to section 18(3) againstrefusal to issue a licence.

For the purpose of this Schedule –

*"articulated vehicle" means any motor vehicle with a trailer drawn thereby which is so constructed and by partial super-imposition attached to the motor vehicle that a substantial part of the weight of the trailer is borne by the motor vehicle; "the payload" of a motor lorry is the gross weight thereof as specified by the manufacturer less the unladen weight.".

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend section 28 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act, Cap. 51:02, to provide for an exemption to a person who is sixty-five years and over from the payment of the prescribed fee for a driver's licence.

This Bill also seeks to substitute for the First Schedule to the Act of a new Schedule which increases certain licence fees and other fees with respect to vehicles.
